SUBJECT: Authorization to Frequency Certify CAP Radios

1. Effective with CAPR 100-1, dtd 26 DEC 2012, para 1-6a, persons who will be maintaining and frequency certifying CAP radios must be authorized by the Wing Director of Communications. These persons must hold one of the following certificates or a comparable military speciality (MIL):

General Radiotelephone Operator License (FCC)
National Association of Business/Emergency Radio certificate (NABER)
Association of Public Safety Communications Officers (APCO) certificate
Society of Broadcast Engineers (SBE) certificate
Personal Communications Industry Association certificate (PCIA)

2. To be authorized, submit a copy of the individual's certificate and a letter asking to be added to the authorization list. The individual does not have to be a CAP member. The Group Communications Officer will normally process the required paperwork. Updated lists will be distributed as required. OPSEC must be observed.
