
Lewis Composite Squadron Members Receive CPR/AED and First Aid Training

Members of IL-329 Lewis Composite Squadron participated in the Heartsaver CPR/AED and First Aid training being held on February 25, 2023 at Station #6 of the Lockport Township Fire Protection District, with a second session scheduled for March 4th. In total, 23 senior members and cadets of the squadron are expected to receive their certification, valid for two years. The training was led by LTFPD Firefighters Ashley Davis and Wade Libner, and provided hands-on cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) instruction at the infant, child and adult levels, as well as training on the use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs). Participants also received instruction on the use of tourniquets to stop bleeding, immobilizing broken limbs, and other health issues requiring first aid.

Lewis Composite Squadron has discussed with its members the importance of this type of training, especially considering the emergency services provided by Civil Air Patrol. Firefighters Davis and Libner were extremely informative and engaging in their instruction. This was a great opportunity for IL-329 members to receive training that could potentially benefit all those with whom they come into contact.


Illinois Wing goes to Washington for National Legislative Day in-person and virtually




