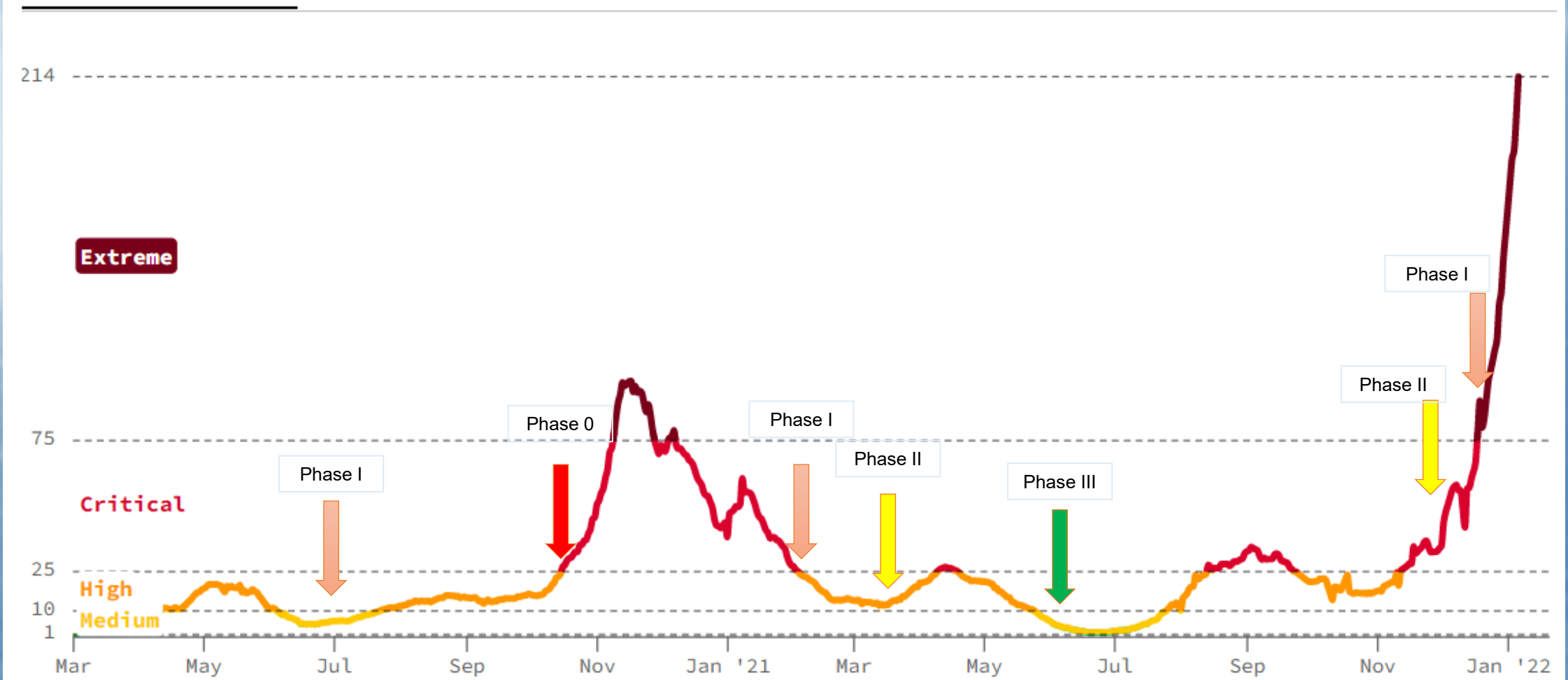

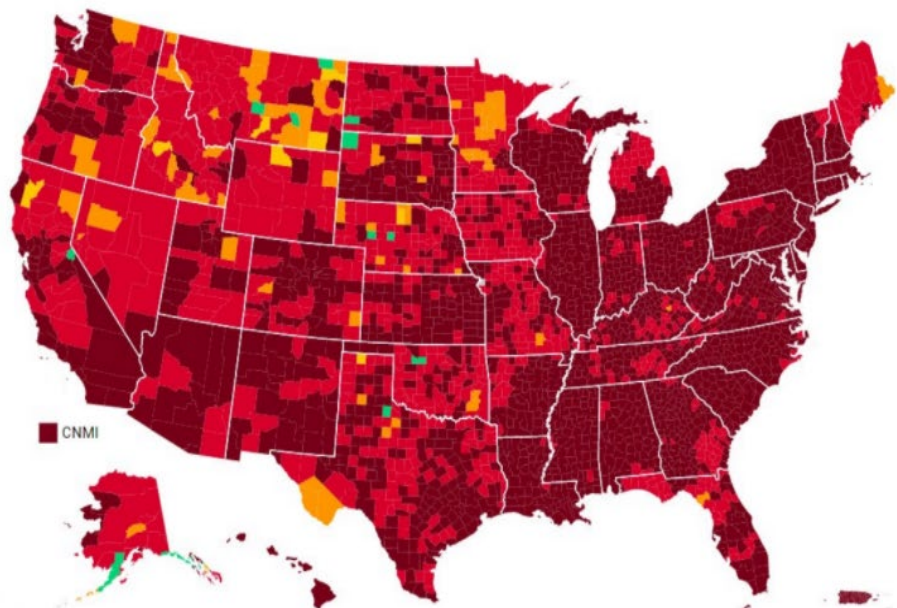
# ILWG COVID-19 REMOBILIZATION TIMELINE

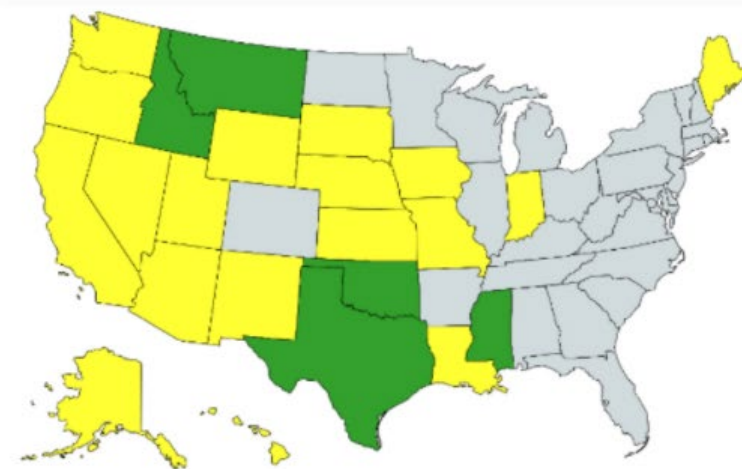

# ACTIVITIES ALLOWED IN PHASE I

## Low-risk / reduced exposure Meetings of <10

- Full-day (but no overnights)
- Practicing CoVID prevention best practices
- Consider A Flt / B Flt alternating meetings for larger units
- AE Activities / Prof Dev Sessions / Workshops / etc.

## Continued Virtual or Hybrid Meetings

- Encourage continued engagement remotely for at-risk members

## Flying / ES Training

- Aircrew Training, Proficiency Flights, Check-Rides, etc.
- O-Flights still allowed, with only ONE cadet per sortie
- SAREXs (but no overnight bivouacs)

## Daily New Cases at/below 40 per 100,000 Residents

- Illinois last saw 40/100K back on 1 Dec 21

## Infection Rate at/below 0.95

- We were there on 17 Oct 21

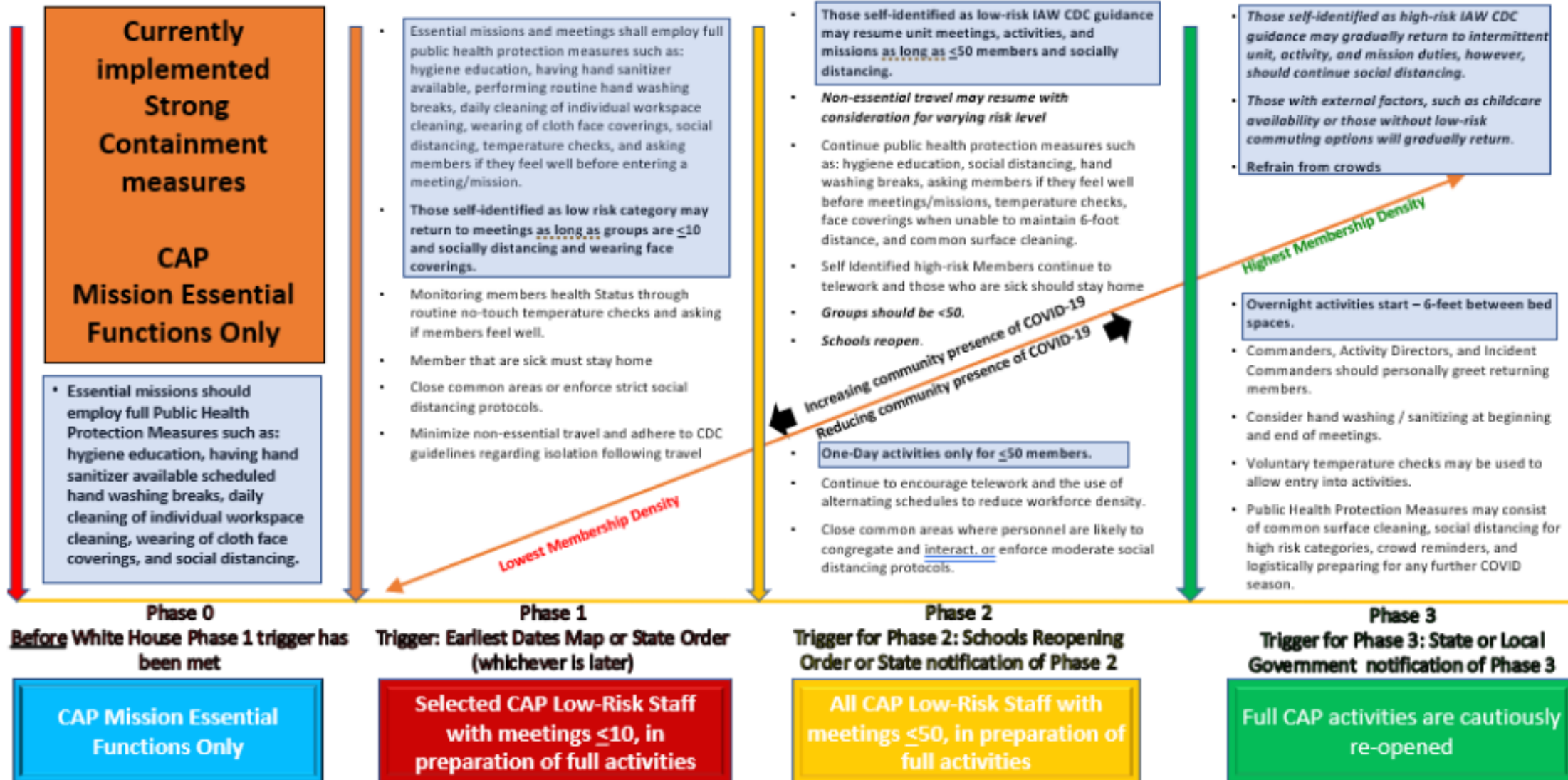
## 28-day Favorable Trending

- Watching Europe for leading indicators
- When IL cases peak and start to retreat, we set an optimistic goal four weeks out
- Submit our Phase II Plan to NHQ two weeks in advance
- Notify IL Wing Staff, Unit Commanders, and Activity Directors at least one week in advance





# CAP COVID-19 "Remobilization of the Membership" Graphic



- Members Self Identify risk to themselves and family member IAW CDC guidance and notify their supervisor.
- This scale is bidirectional the dynamic nature of the COVID-19 status will require continued re-evaluation
- Phase of operation will be identified by the State or City Government in which the Unit or Activity is operated
