





Note 8: Good ventilation in facilities and vehicles reduces the risk of transmission. Recommend air vents set to outside (no recirculation) in vehicles during periods of high or substantial transmission or when unvaccinated members travel in vehicles.

ACTIVITIES ALLOWED IN PHASE I (REVISED 31 JAN22)



Meetings/Activity Participants ≤ 25 indoors ≤ 50 outdoors

- Full-day (overnights on a case-by-case basis)
- Still Masked-Up; Still taking temperatures
- Consider A Flt / B Flt alternating meetings for larger units (or cohorts)
- Guests/Visitors/Prospects are permitted

Continued Virtual or Hybrid Meetings

Encourage continued engagement remotely for at-risk members

Flying / ES Training

- Aircrew Training, Proficiency Flights, Check-Rides, etc.
- O-Flights (w/no occupancy limits)
- SAREXs

PREPARING FOR PHASE II (UNDER REVISED THRESHOLDS)



ILWG CoVID Remobilization Committee members monitor several data sources DAILY

Committee meets every week to discuss trends, review proposed activities, and plans for the next Phase

Daily New Cases at/below 40 per 100,000 Residents

- Illinois' statewide numbers should be met this week
- Some IL counties (with CAP unit locations) have higher case rates.
- CoVID Committee will wait for those counties to change status prior to recommending Phase change

Infection Rate at/below 0.95

• Statewide number was met on 14 Jan

14-day Favorable Trending

- IL CoVID cases peaked on 12 Jan; improving since then
- Submit our Phase II transition date to NHQ for review
- Notify IL Wing Staff, Unit Commanders, and Activity Directors at least one week in advance

PREPARING FOR PHASE III (UNDER REVISED THRESHOLDS)

REMOIS WING

Daily New Cases at/below ≤ 30 per 100,000 Residents

- Based on current trend, Illinois' statewide numbers should be met in the next few weeks
- CoVID Committee will pay particular attention to case rates in counties where CAP units are located

Infection Rate at/below 0.95

• Statewide number was met on 14 Jan

14-day Favorable Trending

- Careful analysis of continuing trends (w/no blips)
- Submit our Phase III transition date to NHQ for review
- Notify IL Wing Staff, Unit Commanders, and Activity Directors at least one week in advance

* CAP will follow the most restrictive policies (local, facility, etc.)

New CAP Phase III restrictions are just shy of "Ops Normal."

Committee will NOT recommend a Phase change unless we are confident Phase III is appropriate




